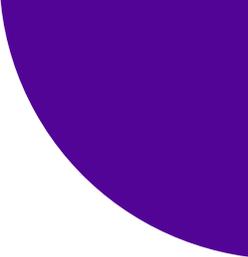
Purpose

- **Address Inequities:** Develop skills to identify and address inequities in educational settings.
- **Foster Cultural Competence:** Enhance cultural competence and incorporate culturally responsive teaching practices.
- **Evaluate and Adapt E-DEI Practices:** Use feedback and data to assess the effectiveness of E-DEI practices and make necessary adjustments

Target Groups

The E-DEI in Education program is designed for primary and secondary school teachers, school counselors, curriculum developers, and school administrators. A minimum of B2 (Upper-Intermediate) English proficiency is required.
